### **Topic**

Our class topic this term is 'Beachcombers'. As part of this topic the children will be reading and writing stories about beaches, also writing facts about beaches and what can be found there. In art we will be using clay to model with and sand to create pictures. In geography we will be looking at the features of our coastlines and seaside holiday destinations around the world (if you have a photo of your family at a seaside, either home or abroad, send it in and we will put in on our map). All other subjects will be linked to this theme where appropriate.

## **Homework**

Spellings for this term have already been sent out. Please send the children with their homework books on Thursdays. Children need to write a sentence which includes each word in their homework books. Spelling tests will be on Thursday and books will be given back on Friday.

Maths- maths homework will be set online via the Mathletics website. The children all have a login in their homework books. You are able to download the app free for tablets.

Reading- home readers will be checked at school once a week. The books will be changed when we feel a child is not only confident with reading the text and key words but also understands the story or fact book. Re-read the book several times to encourage fluency. See the questions at the back of the book to aid your child at home. Please fill in the reading journal and should your child finish a book feel free to write in extra books they have read from home.

#### PE

PE this term will be on a **Friday** with me and **Thursday** afternoon with MSP Coach Alex. Children will need to have their PE kits in school at all times. A PE kit should include: T-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, socks, tracksuit bottoms and top and trainers. Please label all items of clothing.
