Autumn Term 1



This term our topic is 'All About Me' and 'People Who Help Us'

This topic is designed for the children and staff to get to know each other and create new friends. We will be playing lots of team building and friendship games to aid these new relationships. After we have settled in we will learn about people who help us, if you know anybody who would like to come and talk to the class about their job in our community please get in touch.

We will begin learning phonics through the scheme of Read Write Inc. Children will learn sounds to help them begin to read, children will learn rhymes and songs to help remember each sound. This year we are sending home a ready-made pack of all the sound cards for you to practise at home with your child, please use this as often as you can at home to aid your child's learning.

When we learn new sounds children will be taught to write each letter. This year we are starting pre - cursive writing, attached to this letter is a sheet to show you how your child will be taught to write each letter. Please encourage your child to start every letter on the line and end each letter with a flick. This way of writing ensures they are ready to join up their letters when they start in year 1.

In Mathematics we will be learning the numbers to ten through counting, playing and songs. When children are confident using these numbers we will be solving questions and number problems. Number cards are included in the pack sent home.

Every Tuesday morning we will have Mrs Isle teach us Religious Education and Music.

Home Learning Packs - These packs are being sent home to further your child's learning at home. This pack must be returned to school complete in July. Inside the pack is a bundle of 'tricky words' that your child will learn to read, please practise these as often as possible. When your child has learnt them they will be assessed and given the next set of tricky words. Please keep the pack inside your child's book bag, they need it at school every day.

Don't Forget...

- Our PE day is Thursday, please ensure kits are in school on this day.
 PE kit should include t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, socks, joggers, jacket/jumper and trainers. Earrings must be removed or covered and long hair tied back.
- You can come in your own clothes on your Birthday! If your Birthday falls at a weekend or in the holidays choose the day closest to your birthday.
- Please label all uniform and PE kit including shoes and coats.
- Children can bring a <u>named</u> water bottle in each day to access throughout the day <u>only water in these please</u>.

Our whole school reward system is called Evergreen. Every two weeks children who have earnt their Evergreen will receive a whole school treat. You will receive a text each Friday to inform you if your child is on track to get their Evergreen.
