Curriculum Overview



Dear Children, Parents and Carers,

June 2019

We hope you have all had a restful and enjoyable half term. This term our topic is 'Enchanted Woodland'. We will be learning about different types of trees and flowers. We will spend time in the nature reserve making animal and fairy homes. We will also be growing our own plants and flowers. The topic this term will cover the following things:

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- English RWI Phonics, Stories, Information texts, poems.
- Maths Addition and subtraction, Measuring and fractions
- Science Parts of flowers and plants.
- RE The children will be learning about places of worship are important and will look in particular at a Hindu Mandir and a Muslim Mosque.
- Music Learning how to use our voices creatively by singing songs and speaking chants and rhymes. We will continue to learn how to play the glockenspiel.
- Topic- Alongside our Woodland topic we will be learning about the Great Fire of London.
- PSHE Our topic this term is 'Changing Me'. We will look at how the children's bodies have changed since they were a babies. We will also be learning about different body parts. A separate letter will be sent with permission slips for SRE lessons.

Homework and reading

Homework will be given out on a Tuesday and it may include spellings, English, Maths or topic work. Homework is to be completed in their yellow homework book and handed into the homework tray in class the following <u>Monday</u>. Reading books will be checked and changed regularly and children will be heard to read 1:1 by an adult in the class.

- PE days are **Thursdays and Fridays**. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit with them and that their PE kit is fully labelled. PE kit should include: t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, trainers, socks and a tracksuit.

- Children may bring a bottle of water only into the classroom. Please ensure it is labelled. Now the weather is getting warmer please send children with sunhats, sun cream and extra water when needed.
- Our day to change library books is Mondays. If the children wish to change their book, make sure it is in school on this day. Now swimming is over we will make sure these are changed.
- As we enter the last term of Year 1 we would like to take the opportunity to thank you for all your support over the last year. We have thoroughly enjoyed the year with all the children and we are sure the last term will be just as much fun!
