
Reception Class Newsletter





This term our topic is Minibeasts

Topic - We will be learning about insects and bugs! We will be using lots of books to aid our learning. We will also use the iPads and laptops to help discover our information. We will read the story books 'The Very Lazy Ladybird' 'The Bad Tempered Ladybird' 'Spinderella' 'Slug Needs a Hug' and many more! If children have any minibeast related books/photos etc to share with the class please bring them in.

Maths - In Mathematics we will continue to cover the Early Learning Goal Objectives: To count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Use quantities and objects to add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

Phonics - In Phonics and Literacy we will be using all the sounds we know to read lots of stories and begin to write our own. Please remember to read your school reading book as often as you can to earn stickers for your sticker chart. Please make sure reading books and the record book are in school each day.

Home learning packs - Please can these be returned to school on Friday 28th June. Please ensure everything is put back in the pack on this date ready to be checked at school.

Every Tuesday morning, we will have Mrs Wilson teach us Religious Education and Music.

Collective Worship - This term the theme of Collective Worship is 'Responsibility' children who are seen to be showing this value will be nominated to receive the Tully Cup on a Friday.

TOPIC HOMEWORK - This term our topic is Minibeasts. For your project this term research different insects, you might find out information, make a poster, draw a picture, write a sentence about it or make a 3D model. The choice is yours!
