We hope you have all had a lovely half term. This term our topic is 'Superheroes'. As part of our Topic we would like to invite any parents/carers or grandparents who are real life superheroes eg. firefighters, police officers, doctors, nurses etc in to class to talk to the children about their jobs and what they entail. The topic this term will cover the following things:

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- English RWI Phonics, Superhero fact files, letters, poems.
- Maths Place value to 100, length, height, weight and volume.
- Science The Human Body
- RE Easter
- Music finding the pulse, superhero songs
- Topic-Real Life Superheroes from the past and present eg. Florence Nightingale
- PE Tuesdays with our PE Coach and Thursdays.



Homework and reading

Homework will be given out on a Tuesday and it may include spellings, English, maths or topic work. Homework is to be completed in their yellow homework book and handed into the homework tray in class the following Monday. Reading books will be checked and changed regularly and children will be heard to read 1:1 by an adult in the class. We encourage you to listen to your child read and read to them as much as possible.

- PE days are now **Tuesday** and **Thursday**. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit with them and that their PE kit is fully labelled. PE kit should include: t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, trainers, socks and a tracksuit.
- Children may bring a bottle of water only into the classroom. Please ensure it is labelled.

- Our day to change library books is Mondays. If the children wish to change their book, make sure it is in school on this day.
