

# Term 1 Curriculum Overview

Welcome to Year 1! I hope you have all had a fantastic summer and are refreshed and ready to start the new school year. I would like to take the opportunity to share this term's curriculum with you and other useful information. Our overall topic this term is 'Splendid Skies'.

## Curriculum Overview

- English We follow the Read Write Inc scheme.
- Maths Counting, writing and ordering numbers, addition and subtraction.
- Science Types of animals and what they like to eat.
- RE The Creation Story and Harvest Festival. This lesson will be taken by Mrs Finney.
- Music Weather songs and using instruments creatively.
- Topic (Geography/History/Computing/Art/DT) Based around our 'Splendid Skies' topic.
- PE Mondays with our new MSP Coach and Fridays with Miss Lee.

# Homework and reading

Homework will be given out on a Friday (this can be accessed on Padlet) and it may include spellings, English, Maths or topic work. The children may continue to use Mathletics as a homework tool alongside their weekly homework. Homework is to be completed in their yellow homework book and handed into the homework tray in class the following Thursday. Reading books will be checked and changed regularly and children will be heard to read 1:1 by an adult in the class.

# Evergreen

The school's Evergreen behaviour system will continue into Year 1. Every two weeks children who have kept their Evergreen will receive a whole school treat. As a class we have discussed what kind of behaviour is unacceptable in school and also what good behaviour looks like too. Children are rewarded with team points for superb behaviour in and around school and these contribute to our whole school team point totals every Friday in Assembly.

### General notices

- PE days are <u>Monday</u> and <u>Friday</u>. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit with them and that their PE kit is fully labelled. PE kit should include: t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, trainers, socks and a tracksuit for when the weather becomes cooler.
- Children may bring a bottle of <u>water</u> only into the classroom. Please ensure it is labelled.
- Please make sure children are bringing their book bag into school every day.
- Please make sure all school uniform is labelled, especially school jumpers and cardigans.
- As in Reception, when it is your child's birthday, they may come in their own uniform on that day or the closest day to their birthday if it falls at a weekend or in the holidays.
