<u>Phonics</u>

In Year 1 every child is to take part in a National Phonics Screening check. This will take place in June. I know this might seem a long time away, but it will soon be upon us. It is a quick and easy assessment to check your child's phonics skills and knowledge learnt through Reception and Year 1. In the test the children have to read a list of 40 words of which some will be nonsense words. The reason I am mentioning it now is because I want to highlight the importance of the children reading at home as much as they can. It is essential the children practice their books and know their phonics sounds as best as they can. Please use the laminated sounds sheet that was sent home before the Christmas holidays as much as you can. We do 30 minutes of phonics every day which will be increased nearer to June, alongside various phonics interventions for pupils. Please check the Government website for further details and to view previous years assessments.
