Swimming

This term Year 1 will be going swimming on a Monday afternoon. The children will need:

- > Goggles (optional)
- > Bag (separate to their PE bag)

There will be plenty of staff going swimming, including myself, to help supervise and help the children put swimming hats on.

We will have a big phonics push this term in preparation for the Phonics Screening Test in June. Please continue to keep up the excellent reading at home and learning all the sounds. Practise, practise, practise! ☺

We will be doing another practise phonics screening test in class this term and I will let you know your child's scores.

If you have an iPad at home, *Fonics* app and *Mr Thorne's Phonics Flash Cards* app are fantastic, if you have not already downloaded them.
