## Curriculum Overview

Our two topic projects this term are called 'Let's Explore' and 'Autumn'.

Our main project this term is called 'Let's Explore'. This project teaches children about the environments that they share with others, including their homes, school and places in the local community.

Our mini topic is called 'Let's explore Autumn'. This project teaches children about the natural changes that happen during the season of autumn, including how the weather changes, why trees lose their leaves and how wild animals prepare for winter.

Phonics - We will begin phonics lessons in week 3. We use the Read Write Inc scheme and begin to learn single sounds. Maths - We will be matching, sorting and comparing objects and numbers. We will be focusing on mastering the numbers 1 -5 this term.

RE - We will be focusing on the topic 'Myself' and learning about people who belong to a religious group. Music - In our music lessons we will be learning to sing nursery rhymes and action songs.

PE - Our PE lesson is every Thursday at 9am, long hair needs to be tied up and earrings removed please.

## **General Notices**

**Behaviour system** – In class we have discussed expected and unacceptable behaviour. Children are rewarded with team points for good behaviour in and around school and these contribute to our whole school team point totals. We also choose a star of the week each Friday in Reception Class.

**Birthday**- Your child can come in their own clothes on their birthday. If their birthday falls at the weekend or a school holiday, please choose the day closest to it.

Water bottles - Please only send plain water in these.

Labelling clothes- Please ensure that you have labelled all your child's belongings, including P.E. kit, school uniform, bags, bottles, coats and shoes.

**Weather** – In Reception class we go outside whatever the weather! Please bring a raincoat every day. Please apply sun cream to your child before school on hot days, your child can bring their own sun cream and reapply it themselves at lunchtime. The sun cream must be labelled.
