# **Headteacher Update**

As we start our second lockdown we need to keep you updated on any amendments to our risk assessment as we adapt to this ever changing situation.

The government has said that schools are to remain open and that children are to continue attending. We are delighted to have all the children back in school. We have revised our seating arrangements in KS1 and some KS2 classes as we have found that the children are happier and therefore working better in groups rather than rows. We will continue with our stringent hygiene routines.

However, we need to be prepared for possible increases in staff absences due to self-isolation.

We have made the decision, with agreement from our governors, that we will not be using supply staff to cover short term staff absences as we want to avoid visitors to school. This would only happen if it were a pre-arranged long term absence. You would be informed of this.

This will mean that staff will have to cover different classes and if we do not have enough staff we would have to close a class.

If that were to happen it would be the same as if we had to close due to a suspected/confirmed case of Covid-19, home learning would be provided via Seesaw.

Please be assured that we continue to keep up to date with government guidance to ensure that we are providing the safest possible environment for your children to learn in.

Each child has a Seesaw account which has been updated to their new class. Parent/carers were sent a Parent Hub with the details.
