"Bastion in the Air" travelling exhibitions

These exhibitions focus on the role of Lincolnshire during WW1 there are 2.

They are entitled "Heroes of the Airfield" and "Heroines of the Home Front" and are currently touring the County prior to the opening of 2 major exhibitions at RAF Scampton and The Collection in Lincoln.

"Heroes" talks about the formation of the RAF in this, its centenary year, and "Heroines" is all about the women who had to take on the roles left by the men who went off to fight. "Heroines" will be showing at the Gainsborough Heritage Centre from 2nd February. There will be local interest as many of the women signed up to work at Marshalls as 'Munitionettes' and built Bristol fighter aircraft to help the war effort.

On Tuesday 13th February (half term week) at the Gainsborough Heritage Centre there will be a free children's workshop along with the granddaughter of Daisy Lavendar - a 'Munitionette' who actually worked at Marshalls herself. Daisy was born in London but moved to Gainsborough to marry her sweetheart and lived there for the rest of her life so there will be a lot of references in her story to places the children will recognise. She has a fascinating story which Miriam (her granddaughter) will tell the children. In addition there will be crafts and stories (plus free juice and biscuits!)
