The council is looking at different aspects including heritage, green spaces, the riverside and the town centre. The meeting on Friday is to gather the public's opinions about the Butter Market/Town Hall. The council thinks that it would be good if the Butter Market building could be made to look like it used to and use as an indoor market or an alternative use may be decided by the Gainsborough public.

Our school council will be carrying out a survey on this subject and will present their findings at the meeting with the other school councils from the local area.
