#### The Safe Use of Social Media

We are dealing with more and more incidents relating to the inappropriate use of social media out of school which is spilling into school life. This is particularly affecting friendships and relationships between pupils.

We all need to work together to keep our children safe and to enable us to do this effectively we share information regularly with you via Facebook and Parent Hub.
As individual cases arise we do work directly with parents/carers to support all involved.

However, some of these matters do need dealing with at home in the first instance and a part of being able to do this effectively is for parents/carers to be aware of what their children are accessing and/or being exposed to.

This is ever changing and we are all aware that as soon as we put something in place to safe guard our children, someone, somewhere is working out a way around this.

As a school we are very concerned so we have organised a 
Social Media Awareness Session for any parent/carers of KS 2 pupils. We hope we have given enough notice for time to be booked off work, so as many of you as possible can attend. We cannot express how important it is that parents attend or send a representative. We have coincided the workshop with the Speak Out, Stay Safe sessions being run by the NSPCC with all of the pupils.

#### Year

98% = 4 days absent from school

95% = 10 days absent from school

90% = 4 weeks absent from school

85% = 5 1/2 weeks absent from school

80% = 7 1/2 weeks absent from school

Attendance over 5 years (Y2- Y6)

85 - 90% = About half a year off school.

80% = 38 weeks absent from school one whole year of school missed!

Fact: the more time spent in school, the better your child's attainment.
