## This term our topic is 'Can I switch it on?'

**Topic** - This term we will be learning about different types of technology. We will read stories called 'Webster's Bedtime' 'Chicken Clicking' and 'Troll Stinks' which all focus on using technology safely. In class we will use iPads, laptops and computers to aid our learning. We would also like to know what technology your child uses at home, please fill in the form attached which will go in your child's special folder.

**Maths** - In Mathematics we will begin learning about shapes, space and measures. We will learn how to measure and compare length, weight and capacity.

**Phonics** - In Phonics we will be revisiting all the sounds we have learnt and moving on to new sounds. Please make sure you write in your child's reading record book each time you hear your child read. The reading book and reading record need to be in your child's book bag each day. Please try and practise the sound cards in your home learning pack as often as you can along with your tricky words.

Home reading books - Please write in the record book every time your child practises the book at home with you. Your child is expected to read at least three times a week. Please have the reading book and reading record in school every day. Each time your child reads at home and school they receive a sticker in their reading chart. Some children are soon to receive their bronze award certificate and prize, well done! Pease help us with encouraging your child to read as often as possible to aid their learning. Tricky words will be checked each time your child reads to an adult at school, when your child has learnt them they will be assessed and given the next set of tricky words. Please be aware that after your children has learnt each set of tricky words they will return to the first set to check if they have retained the words. Please keep the pack inside your child's book bag, they need it at school every day.

Every Tuesday morning we will have Mrs McGlynn teach us Religious Education and Music.
