



This term our topic is 'Do cows drink milk?'

Topic - We will be learning about animals that live on the farm! We will be using lots of books to aid our learning fiction and non-fiction. We will also use the iPads and laptops to help discover our information. We will read the story books 'Noisy Farm' 'Farmer Duck' 'What the ladybird heard' and 'Mrs Wishy-Washy's Farm'. If children have any farm related books/photos etc to share with the class, please bring them in.

Maths - In Mathematics we will be covering the Early Learning Goal Objectives: To count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Use quantities and objects to add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

Phonics - In Phonics and Literacy we will be continuing to learn lots of new sounds. Please make sure you write in your child's reading record book each time you hear your child read. The reading book and reading record need to be in your child's book bag each day. Please try and practise the sound cards in your home learning pack as often as you can along with your tricky words. Home reading books - Please write in the record book every time your child practises the book at home with you. Your child is expected to read at **least three times a week**. Please have the reading book and reading record in school every day. Each time your child reads at home and school they receive a sticker in their reading chart. Some children are soon to receive their bronze award certificate and prize, well done! Please help us with encouraging your child to read as often as possible to aid their learning. Tricky words will be checked each time your child reads to an adult at school, when your child has learnt them they will be assessed and given the next set of tricky words. Please be aware that after your children has learnt each set of tricky words they will return to the first set to check if they have retained the words. **Please keep the pack inside your child's book bag, they need it at school every day.**

Every Tuesday morning, we will have Mrs McGlynn teach us Religious Education and Music.

Collective Worship - This term the theme of Collective Worship is 'Perseverance' children who are seen to be showing this value will be nominated to receive the Tully Cup on a Friday.

TOPIC HOMEWORK - This term our topic is Farm animals. For your project this term please research a farm animal, you might find out information, make a poster, draw a picture, write a sentence about it or make a 3D model. The choice is yours! Please bring in your finished projects before Monday 25th March. Homework projects are shown to the whole school in Friday assemblies. They will also be placed on display in our classroom!
