MATHS and ENGLISH

We will consolidate everything we have been learning this year. We are focusing on fractions for the first few weeks and then we will focus on multiplication and division.

In English we will continue to look at comprehension and reading fluency. In writing we will be covering different genres and looking at what the children are able to do independently.

TOPIC

This term our topic is Urban Pioneers. This topic looks mainly at local history. We will be learning about the Anderson family of Lea and will visit Lea Park to see where the Anderson House once stood. We will also compare maps of Lea Village in the past and Lea village today and see how it has changed over time.

SCIENCE

Our topic this term will be light and dark. We will learn how light is reflected from surfaces and how shadows are formed and change. We will also learn about the dangers of the sun and how we can protect our eyes.
