Immediate actions

If you wish to contact your child's class teacher and cannot see them face to face, please e mail <u>enquiries@olive-anderson.lincs.sch.uk</u> and ask for the e mail to be forwarded to the relevant staff member.

The school meals survey is being collated and analysed by a Governor and a summary will be given to parents as soon as it is available.

This year, you will receive an update every term on how your child is progressing as shared at parent consultation. If there is not a face to face meeting or a written report for that term you will receive an overview on behaviour and attainment.

School uniform can be ordered at any point during the year, however, we can send a text reminder at the end of the academic year informing of the deadline for new orders to be put in before the end of term.

We will endeavour to give more notice for trips when help is required.

With regard to meeting the new teachers, this is something I would like to incorporate into the open evening at the end of the summer term when you are all invited into school, following the receipt of your child's report.
