## This term our topic is called 'Do cows drink milk?' This topic will be all about farm animals.

We will be learning about animals that live on the farm! We will be using lots of books to aid our learning fiction and non-fiction. We will also use the iPads and laptops to help discover our information. We will read the story books 'Noisy Farm' 'Farmer Duck' 'What the ladybird heard' and 'Mrs Wishy-Washy's Farm'. If children have any farm related books/photos etc to share with the class please bring them in.

In Phonics and Literacy we will be continuing to learn lots of new sounds. Please continue to encourage your child to read their reading book as many times as possible and ask questions about what they have read. Please can an adult fill in the Reading Record book every time the child reads their book, thank you. Continue to use the phonics pack at home to aid your child's reading. Please visit

In Mathematics we will be covering the Early Learning Goal Objectives: To count reliably with numbers from one to 20, place them in order and say which number is one more or one less than a given number. Use quantities and objects to add and subtract two single-digit numbers and count on or back to find the answer. Solve problems, including doubling, halving and sharing.

Every Thursday morning we have Mrs Sweeney teach us Religious Education, this term we will be focusing on the topic 'Special places'.

TOPIC HOMEWORK - This term our topic is Farm animals. For your project this term research a farm animal, you might find out information, make a poster, draw a picture, write a sentence about it or make a 3D model. The choice is yours! Please bring in your finished projects before Monday 15<sup>th</sup> May. Homework projects are shown to the whole school in Friday assemblies. They will also be placed on display in our classroom!

Junk modelling – Children enjoy making things in the classroom using old boxes and tubes, if you ever have an recycling please bring in for our junk modelling box. (kitchen roll tubes are fine but not toilet roll tubes, thank you)

## Don't Forget...
