Worry box	The worry box is not being used appropriately	School council representatives are to continue to remind classes about the worry box and its purpose. Remind children that worries will be addressed every two weeks during school council meetings.
Top and bottom doors at KS2 and rules regarding toilets at lunchtime.	Currently the door monitors are only permitting children to enter and exit the school at lunchtime via the top door. This was discussed at school council. Some children stated that they were not allowed to use the toilet at lunchtime and therefore they felt children were 'sneaking' in both doors.	Gracie and Elise and Sophie to work on ppt. Agreed at school council that rules of lunchtime would be revisited. 6 lunchtime bands. 2 door monitors on both top and bottom doors. Children to be politely asked why they are entering school, where they are going and to be reminded not to loiter near lockers or toilets.
Library area	Children would like a quiet area for reading and relaxing time. They love the new library, but feel that because it is used for interventions, they can't use it how they would like to. Apparently there used to be a quiet reading area in the front entrance.
