Minutes from last meeting	Toilets – children enquiring as to when the toilets will be finished.	Mrs Malone to liaise with Mrs Woolley. Mrs Woolley has confirmed that the toilets are currently being completed.
Worry Box	<p>Mrs Malone discussed the current position of the worry box and spoke about how appropriate worries included in the box would be discussed at school council.</p> <p>Within the box there were lots of statements linked to fears of spiders, witches etc. A couple of worries linked to having no-one to play with at break and lunch.</p> <p>Mrs Malone stated that she was unaware of the exact location of the 'Buddy bench' and maybe this needed to be given more prominence in school. The current location of the buddy bench is not suitable for KS1.</p>	<p>All school council representatives are to talk to their classes about the position and purpose of the worry box.</p> <p>Mrs Malone is to deliver an assembly on 15th November about kindness and creative ideas to show kindness. Elise and Sophie will take photos of the current buddy bench as they feel some children are unaware of its presence.</p> <p>Long term – discussed the possibility of having 2 buddy benches – one for KS1 and one for KS2.</p> <p>Where would be the most suitable location for each of these buddy benches?</p>
Lunch time games and activities	All classes felt that there was a lack of activities/games provided for wet play times. They would like the school to invest in purchasing more games that are suitable – not monopoly style games which take too long to set up and play.	Mrs Malone discussed Mrs Woolley's idea for a maths game library. Perhaps these games could also be used to support wet play times.
