I am writing to provide you with an overview of the curriculum for this term up until February Half Term. Our new topic this term is 'Bright Lights, Big City'. We will be basing this around The Great Fire of London.

Phonics

In Year 1 every child is to take part in a National Phonics Screening check. This will take place in June. I know this might seem a long time away, but it will soon be upon us. It is a quick and easy assessment to check your child's phonic skills and knowledge learnt through Reception and Year 1. In the test the children have to read a list of 40 words and nonsense words. The reason I am mentioning it now is because I want to highlight the importance of the children reading at home as much as they can. It is essential the children practice their books and know their phonics sounds as best as they can. We do 30 minutes of phonics every day which will be increased nearer to June, alongside various phonics interventions for pupils.
