4. Matters Arising

Review of the School Disco

A total of £341.65 raised before any deductions for food and drinks costs.

- Parents Room – this idea was discussed again and to provide tea and coffee in another room. A large number of parents stopped restricting the amount of room the children had for dancing and playing games in the hall.
- Discussed ideas such as a beetle drive, children's bingo or movie nights. Classrooms have projectors so would be able to use several rooms and show different films to accommodate all ages.
