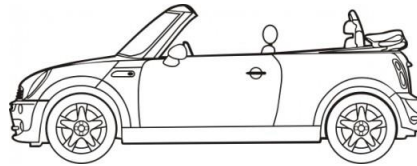
Donations for the event such as jarbola, tombola and wine are welcome from June 20<sup>th</sup>. Cakes on the day please.
