Behaviour and Safety at School

I was thrilled with the responses the children made when I asked them their views on the behaviour of pupils and how they can and do keep themselves safe. Very few thought there was any bullying and most could explain that bullying is when a person does something 'several times, on purpose' to hurt another pupil either physically or verbally.

- 100% of pupils interviewed said they are proud of our school
- 100% feel that the high 5 rules are good
- 100% like the EVERGREEN system
- 100% state that they feel safe at school.

The pupils interviewed did feel that behaviour could be better at lunch times as there is some play fighting. In light of this I met with the school council who decided that pupils should receive one reminder only about play fighting and if the behaviour is repeated then EVERGREEN will be lost and parents informed.

We have consciously provided more equipment at lunch time and are recognising positive play which is rewarded verbally and with team points.
