## This term our topic is called 'Are we there yet?' This topic will be all about Transport and People who help us!

We will be learning about the people who help us in our community, this will include fire fighters, hospital workers and the police along with many others. We will spend time learning about their vehicles and how they use them to get around. This will then lead into our topic on transport where will learn about different ways of travelling past and present.

In Phonics and Literacy we will be continuing to learn lots of new sounds. Please continue to encourage your child to read their reading book as many times as possible and ask questions about what they have read. Please can an adult fill in the Reading Record book every time the child reads their book, thank you. Continue to use the phonics pack at home to aid your child's reading. In Mathematics we will be learning how to finds the total number of items in two groups by counting all of them. We will be learning how to say the number that is one more than a given number up to 10. We will also begin to add and subtract using numbers to 10.

Every Thursday morning we have Mrs Sweeney teach us Religious Education, this term we will be focusing on the topic 'Special times in my life.'

TOPIC HOMEWORK - As we are learning about transport this term your project is to think about what your favourite type of transport is and why. You may want to find information out about this type of transport or paint a picture! You may make a poster with pictures and information to show the class or even make a 3D model! The choice is yours but have something ready to bring in on Monday  $6^{th}$  February to share with the whole class. Get creative!

DRESS UP DAY – In Reception class we have decided to have a People Who Help Us dressing up day on Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> February. Children are allowed to come to school dressed as a person who helps in our community, this may be fire fighters, doctors, nurses, paramedics, bus drivers, teachers, builders, mechanics or many more!
