Topic

Our class topic this term is 'Global Gardens'. During this topic we will be finding out about gardens around the world and the adaptations of different plants in different climates. In Science we will looking at plants. In art we will be studying the artist Claude Monet and learning water colour techniques. All other subjects will be linked to the topic where possible.

Homework

Please fill in the reading journal and should your child finish a book feel free to write in extra books they have read from home.

PE

PE this term will be on Monday afternoon with me and a Thursday afternoon when Coach Chris will be working with them. Children will need to have their PE kits in school at all times. A PE kit should include: T-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, tracksuit bottoms and top and trainers. Please label all items of clothing.

Other

- We will have 'Show and Tell' on a Friday, this is for children to tell any
 interesting news from home or to show an item of interest to do with the topic.
 Please can you ensure your child does not bring in any toys. 'Show and Tell' is
 optional, don't feel they have to say or show every week.
- SATS testing will take place this term, they have to be completed by the end of May for Maths (Arithmetic and Problem Solving), reading and SPAG. The children will be taken out the class in small groups and given as much time and encouragement as possible. The children do not feel any pressure from school.
