Curriculum Overview

To begin the term, there is going to be a focus on writing, as we near the assessment deadlines. The children will be editing and improving their written work, with the aim of achieving the criteria to be 'working at the expected standard'.

In maths, the children will be applying the skills they have learnt over the last year to real-life situations and project work. This should help many of them to become masters in the mathematics curriculum.

In other subjects, the topics for this term are:

- **Science:** Completion of living things in their habitats, followed by puberty (cross curricular with PSHE)
- **Topic (Geography/History/Art):** Rio
- **RE:** What can we learn from the life of Jesus?
- **PSHE-** Changes: Sports Day, stranger danger, sex and relationships (how the body works and changes in puberty), risk taking and dealing with pressure, transition arrangements
- **ICT-** Computer Programming
- **PE-** Coach Chris will be teaching athletics this term and we will be doing additional sporting activities in preparation for Sports Day
- **Drama/Music/Speaking and Listening-** The Lion King!

Although the children have been given a break from regular homework, they should continue to learn their times tables, practise spellings and could also keep working through their SATs homework booklets, in preparation for starting secondary school. In addition to this, they should try to put extra practise at home into learning lines and songs ready for their end-of-year performance of the Lion King.
