Curriculum Overview



- English - RWI Phonics, Recounts, Information texts, poems, narratives.
- Maths - Place Value to 100, Multiplication and Division.
- Science - Seasonal changes, Trees and Plants.
- RE - Places of Worship.
- Music - "How does music help us to understand our neighbours?" We will be learning to listen, sing, play, compose and perform.
- Geography - How did that get there? We will be learning about human and physical features.
- History - 'Who is the greatest explorer?'. We will learn about Christopher Columbus and Neil Armstrong
- PE - Striking and Fielding (Friday) and Athletics (Tuesday).
- PSHE - Relationships and Changing Me

Homework

- Please continue to read to and listen to your child as much as possible and record this on boom reader. RWI books will continue to be changed weekly. Please support your child to learn any sounds they are unsure of.
- Phonics screener videos will be shared weekly on seesaw. Please support your child to read the alien and real words at home.
- Home learning ideas for Maths and topic will also be shared on seesaw.

General notices

- PE days are **Tuesdays and Wednesdays**. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit with them and that their PE kit is fully labelled. PE kit should include: t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, trainers, socks and a tracksuit.
