We hope you have all had a restful and enjoyable Easter Holiday. For the next two terms our topic is 'School Days'. We will be learning about the local area and school life and comparing it to Victorian times. The topic this term will cover the following things:

- Science Seasonal changes, Trees and Plants.

- Please continue to read to and listen to your child as much as possible. RWI books will continue to be changed weekly. Please support your child to learn any sounds they are unsure of.
- Phonics screener word lists will be sent home weekly this term. Please support your child to read the alien and real words at home.
- Ideas for home learning will be shared on seesaw. If you wish to complete any with your child, please share pictures on seesaw or send them into class to be shared by your child.

## General notices

- PE days are **Tuesdays and Fridays**. Please ensure your child has the correct PE kit with them and that their PE kit is fully labelled. PE kit should include: t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls, trainers, socks and a tracksuit.
