

Assessment

Pupils regularly assess their own work throughout the learning journey within a unit and over the years as they re visit key concepts. Pupils recall previous learning, vocabulary, learn new skills and practice these to improve performance. They reflect individually, with peers and as a whole class during the design, make and evaluate stages of the process. Teachers question and challenge pupils at all stages as AFL and formative assessment, give time for improvement, which improves progress.
