

At Frances Olive Anderson Primary School, we follow the Read Write Inc programme to teach phonics. Daily, discrete phonics teaching is taught across KS1 and into KS2. Children start this programme as soon as they start school in Reception.

Within RWI sessions children learn the 44 sounds and the corresponding letters using simple picture prompts. They learn to sound-blend words using Fred talk with help from Fred the Frog.

Once children are blending accurately, they will start to read from a range of storybooks and non-fictions books matched to their phonic knowledge. They will bring home the paper copy of the book they are reading in school, another book closely matched to the sounds they are learning and a reading for pleasure book.
