Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Happy New Year! We hope you all enjoyed the Christmas break.

Curriculum Overview

Our main topic this term is called 'Kings, Queens and Fairytales'. Your child will learn about lots of different traditional Fairytales as well as learn about Kings and Queens from the past and present, design a family crest, locate London on a map of the UK, and design and build a junk model castle.

Our mini topic this term is called "Winter". Your child will learn all about the changes that happen during winter, including the types of weather associated with winter. They will also learn about places that have snow all year round and the types of animals that live there.

Supporting your child at home with this topic

- Go on a winter walk, looking for signs of winter.
- Share lots of fairytale stories with your child.
- Encourage your child to talk about the activities they enjoy doing at school.

Phonics - We will continue to have daily Phonics lessons and learn our Set 1 sounds. Some children will begin to learn set 2 sounds.

Maths - We will be focusing on numbers 5-10 this term.

RE - Our RE topic this half term is called "Our Special Books". We will be learning all about stories from different religions.

Music - Our topic this half term is 'Everyone!'. We will learn lots of action songs.

PE - Our PE lesson is every Wednesday at 9am, long hair needs to be tied up and earrings removed please.

Reading

Home readers - Please use the boom reader app to record each time your child reads at home. Please ensure your child brings their reading book to school every day.

Library books - Every Friday Reception class will visit the school library. Children are allowed to take one book home to share with their grown-ups each week. We then expect the book to be returned on the following Friday to exchange for a new book.

Tapestry accounts - Please upload photos and videos of things your child gets up to at home that they would like to share with the class in show and tell time.

General Notices

Behaviour system - In class we have discussed expected and unacceptable behaviour. Children are rewarded with team points for good behaviour in and around school and these contribute to our whole school team point totals. We also choose a star of the week each Friday in Reception Class.

Birthday - Your child can come in their own clothes on their birthday. If their birthday falls at the weekend or a school holiday, please choose the day closest to it.

Water bottles - Please only send plain water in these.

Labelling clothes - Please ensure that you have labelled all your child's belongings, including P.E. kit, school uniform, bags, bottles, coats and shoes.

Weather - In Reception Class we go outside whatever the weather! Please bring a raincoat every day.
