Dear Parents, Carers and Children,

Curriculum Overview

Our two topic projects this term are called '<u>Animal Safari</u>' and '<u>Creep, Crawl and Wriggle</u>'. Our main project this term is called 'Animal Safari'. In the Animal Safari project, your child will learn about incredible animals that live worldwide. They will explore various animal habitats and compare the animals that live there with animals in their locality. They will learn how to care for pets and what all animals need to grow, survive and stay happy and healthy. They will explore animal features and find out how they survive in the wild. They will compare the ways that animals are similar and different. Our mini topic this half term is "Creep, Crawl and Wriggle". We will be learning all about minibeasts. We will observe minibeasts in their natural habitats and create shelters for them to live in. We will learn about the life cycle of a butterfly and explore what minibeasts, such as snails and worms, need to survive. We will also compare the features of minibeasts and learn the names of their body parts.

Phonics - We will continue to have daily Phonics lessons and learn Set 2 sounds.

Maths - We will be learning all about numbers 11-20, as well as 3D shapes.

RE - Our R.E. topic this half term is "Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians?' We will be learning all about what the Bible says about God.

Music - Our topic this half term is 'Big Bear Funk'.

PE - Our PE lesson is every Wednesday at 9am, long hair needs to be tied up and earrings removed please.

General Notices

Behaviour system – In class we have discussed expected and unacceptable behaviour. Children are rewarded with team points for good behaviour in and around school and these contribute to our whole school team point totals.
