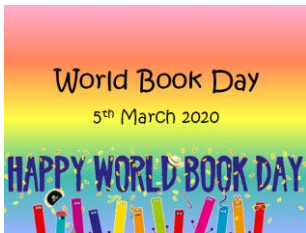
### SIAMS Inspection
