<u>Topic</u>

Our topic this term is Coastline. This project teaches children about the geography of the UK Coastline and those around the world. They will be learning about maps, keys, symbols and the human and physical features.

In science we will be learning about materials and their properties and plants.

<u>Homework</u>

Reading- Home readers will be checked using our new digital reading App and 2 new books will be given out every Friday. Re-read the book several times to encourage fluency. See the questions at the back of the book to aid your child at home. Please fill in the reading journal on the App and should your child finish a book feel free to write in extra books they have read from home. If children have recorded on their Reading journal that they have read at least 3 x per week they will receive a sticker towards a reading certificate. Some children will now be moving off the Read Write Inc scheme and onto a different scheme. The children are taking it in turns to bring home our reading dog, Bruce, their choice in name \bigcirc . They are loving it, please help them post a picture or a video on Seesaw.

Maths- Useful Apps are: Hit The Button, White Rose 1 minute maths and TTRockstars.

Topic- I will post ideas on Seesaw.

Spelling- practice the weekly spellings on 'Spelling Shed' and words they still need to learn in the Common Exception word list.

<u> PE</u>
