Topic

Homework

Reading- Home readers will be checked using the BOOM READER reading App. If your child is on the RWI books they will receive 2 new ones every Friday, otherwise their books will been changed when they have completed them (please make sure you record this on the APP so we know). Re-read the book several times to encourage fluency. See the questions at the back of the book to aid your child at home. Please record every time they have read on the App and should your child finish a book feel free to write in extra books they have read from home. If children have recorded on the App that they have read at least 3 x per week they will receive a sticker towards a reading certificate.

Some children will now be moving off the Read Write Inc scheme and onto a different scheme. The children are taking it in turns to bring home our reading dog, Bruce, their choice in name $^{\textcircled{}}$. They are loving it, please help them post a picture or a video on **Seesaw**.

Maths- Useful Apps are: Hit The Button, White Rose 1 minute maths and TTRockstars.

Topic- Topic homework ideas are on Seesaw.

Spelling- practice the weekly spellings on '**Spelling Shed**' and words they still need to learn on the Common Exception word list.

Logins- All children should have logins for BOOM READER, EDSHED (spelling), TTROCKSTARS & SEESAW. If you are missing any please let me know.
